- Maiden Newton Parish Council is committed to equal opportunity for all sectors of the community.

- The Parish Council will investigate and respond appropriately to any allegation of unacceptable behaviour.
- The Parish Council will ensure that consultations with members of the community it serves are conducted in a fair manner and are accessible to all sectors of the community as appropriate.
- Maiden Newton Parish Council is committed to reviewing this policy and good practice at regular intervals.
